EVALUATION SCORING SCALE

< 5/10 = poor variety and should not be seriously considered 5/10 = variety displays some negative attributes but needs further consideration

6/10 = variety is equal to the current commercial varieties available to growers and should be trialed by individual growers to see if it works for them. 6.5/10 = variety is showing that it is superior to current commercial varieties and should be seriously considered for commercial planting.

7/10 and above = variety is very good and is highly recommended for growers to consider planting commercially.

An interspecific plum with a maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 53mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 19%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 09/02/2014 Overall Score: 6/10

An interspecific plum with a blushed maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 53mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very swwet flavour and a brix of 21%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 10/02/2014

FTPCP 062

A complex interspecific with a maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 54mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 19%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 10/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTN 0713

A white nectarine with a dark red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 72mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 16%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 11/02/2014 Overall Score: 6/10



FTP 0115

A white peach with a red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 77mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 11/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTIP 0216

An interspecific plum with a maroon skin. A slightly flat shape with an average size of 56mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 20%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 12/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTIP 063

An interspecific plum with a blushed maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 52mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 24%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 12/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTIP 0612

An interspecific plum with a blushed maroon skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 50mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 24%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 14/02/2014 Overall Score: 6/10



FTIP 0310

An interspecific plum with a blushed maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 53mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 22%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. Evaluator notes there was a lot of cracking due to approximately 95mm of rain.

An interspecific plum with a purple skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 67mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 19%. An average flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 21/02/2014 Overall Score: 6.5/10



Flavor Treat

A interspecific plum with a maroon skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 56mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 20%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 21/02/2014 Overall Score: 6/10



FTIP 026

An interspecific plum with a blushed maroon skin. An oblong shape with an average size of 59mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 21%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 21/02/2014

Overall Score: 6/10



FTPCP 072

A complex interspecific with a maroon skin. An oblong shape with an average size of 56mm. A crisp, crunchy and juciy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 24%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 22/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTIP 103

An interspecific plum with a solid maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 68mm. A coarse flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 18%. An average flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 22/02/2014 Overall Score: 5/10



FTIP 113

A interspecific plum with a maroon skin. An oblong shape with an average size of 64mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 16%. A commercial flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 23/02/2014 Overall Score: 6.5/10



FTIP 031

An interspecific plum with a maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 53mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a blanaced, slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 20%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 23/02/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTP 044

A yellow peach with a blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 71mm. A medium textured flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 17%. An average flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 03/03/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTP 115

A white peach with a blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 74mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 03/03/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10



FTIP 091

An interspecific plum with a maroon skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 58mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 20%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 04/03/2014 Overall Score: 5/10



FTP 018

A yellow peach with a dark red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 71mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 13%. An average flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 04/03/2014 Overall Score: 6/10

A white peach with a dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 76mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 10/03/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10

A white peach with a blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 72mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 14/03/2014 Overall Score: 6/10

A white peach with a blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 75mm. A medium textured, juicy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 14/03/2014 Overall Score: 6/10



FTP 0215

A white peach with a blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 78mm. A crunchy, juicy flesh with a slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 13%. A light flower density and crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 19/03/2014 Overall Score: 5.5/10
