All of the following evaluations have been evaluated in **The Riverland, South Australia**.

### **EVALUATION SCORING SCALE**

< 5/10 = poor variety and should not be seriously considered

5/10 = variety displays some negative attributes but needs further consideration

6/10 = variety is equal to the current commercial varieties available to growers and should be trialed by individual growers to see if it works for them.

6.5/10 = variety is showing that it is superior to current commercial varieties and should be seriously considered for commercial planting.

7/10 and above = variety is very good and is highly recommended for growers to consider planting commercially.

A white nectarine with a dark red skin. An oblong shape with an average size of 69mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 12%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

### **FTP 0320**

A yellow peach with a 60% blushed red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 73mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 14%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 20/11/2013

Overall Score: 5/10



### **FTP 0718**

A yellow peach with 80% blushed red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 67mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 14%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 20/11/2013

Overall Score: 6.5/10



### **Amigo 1**

An interspecific plum with a solid purple skin. A slightly flat shape with an average size of 57mm. A soft and juicy flesh with slightly flavour and a brix of 16%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

Overall Score: 6/10



### **FTN 0912**

A yellow nectarine with 60% blushed red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 67mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 20/11/2013

Overall Score: 5.5/10

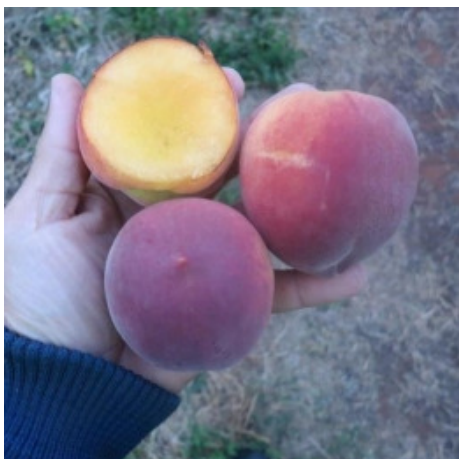


### **Priabel Cot**

An apricot with 20% red blush over yellow skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 49mm. A juicy, medium textured flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 19%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 21/11/2013

Overall Score: 5/10

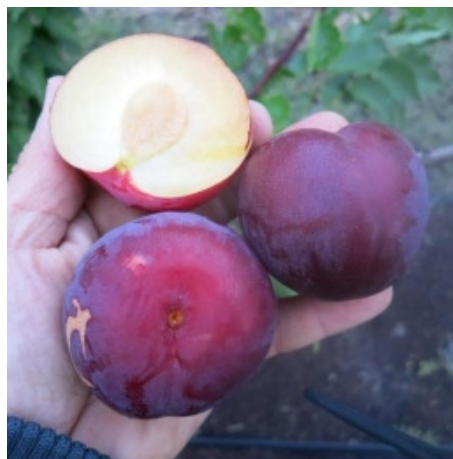


### **FTP 049**

A yellow peach with 75% dark red blushed skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 63mm. A soft and juicy flesh with slightly sweet and balanced flavour and a brix of 12%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 21/11/2013

Overall Score: 5/10

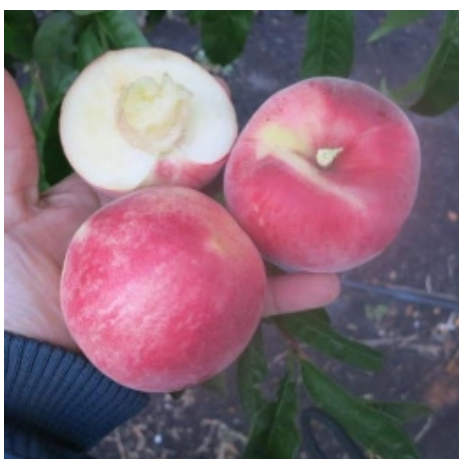


### **Rubirosa PBR**

A plum with solid maroon skin. A slightly flat shape with an average size of 57mm. A soft and juicy flesh with slightly sweet balanced flavour and a brix of 16%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 22/11/2013

Overall Score: 6/10

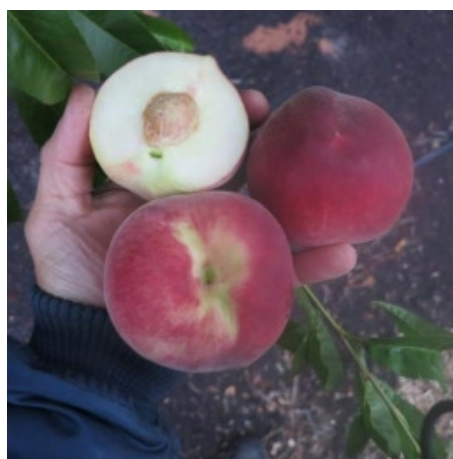


### **FTP 091**

A white peach with 80% dark red blushed skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 73mm. A soft and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

### **FTP 0720**

A white peach with 70% blushed red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 72mm. A soft and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 14%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

Overall Score: 5/10

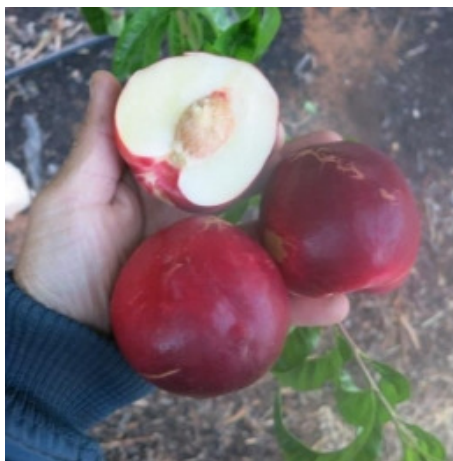


### **Brittney Lane**

A yellow peach with 80% dark red blushed skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 74mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with an acid flavour and a brix of 10%. A heavy flower density and heavy crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 23/11/2013

Overall Score: 6.5/10



### **FTN 0417**

A white nectarine with a solid dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 69mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with slightly sweet balanced flavour and a brix of 12%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 23/11/2013

Overall Score: 6.5/10



### **FTP 0415**

A yellow peach with 80% blushed dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 73mm. A juicy and medium textured flesh with slightly sweet balanced flavour and a brix of 11%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 23/11/2013

Overall Score: 5.5/10



### **FTIA 011**

An interspecific apricot with a yellow and 20% blushed red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 50mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with slightly sweet, balanced flavour and a brix of 18%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 24/11/2013

Overall Score: 7/10



### **Bonny**

An apricot with yellow and 20% red blushed skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 50mm. A juicy, medium textured flesh with slightly sweet balanced flavour and a brix of 17%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 24/11/2013

Overall Score: 7/10



### **FTIA 077**

An interspecific apricot with an orange skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 56mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with slightly sweet, acid flavour and a brix of 16%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season. Evaluator comments, "Tart skin but nice flesh flavour. Slight stone cavity."

First Pick: 24/11/2013

Overall Score: 7/10



### **FTP 0721**

A white peach with 80% blushed dark red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 74mm. A juicy, fine and melting flesh with slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 14%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 24/11/2013

Overall Score: 7/10



### **FTP 095**

A yellow peach with 70% blush red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 67mm. A soft and juicy flesh with slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 13%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 24/11/2013

Overall Score: 5/10



### **FTN 0714**

A white nectarine with a 70% blushed red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 65mm. A crunchy and juicy flesh with very sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

Overall Score: 6.5/10

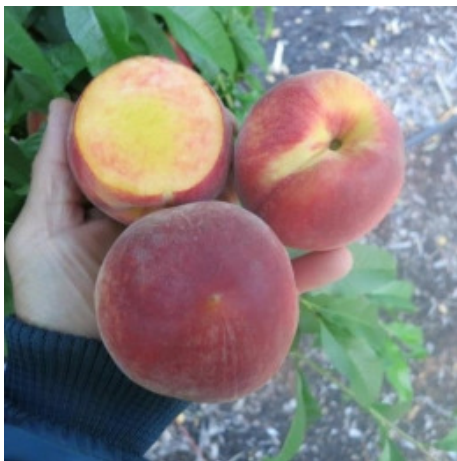


### **FTP 0719**

A yellow peach with 80% solid dark red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 70mm. A soft and juicy flesh with a slightly sweet, balanced flavour and a brix of 11%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

Overall Score: 6.5/10



### **FTP 057**

A yellow peach with 70% dark red blush skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 74mm. A juicy and medium textured flesh with slightly sweet, balanced flavour and a brix of 13%. A commercial flower density and commercial crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 25/11/2013

Overall Score: 6.5/10



### **FTN 021**

A yellow nectarine with solid dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 65mm. A juicy flesh with slightly sweet flavour and a brix of 15%. A light flower density and light crop load were recorded for this season.

First Pick: 26/11/2013

Overall Score: 6.5/10



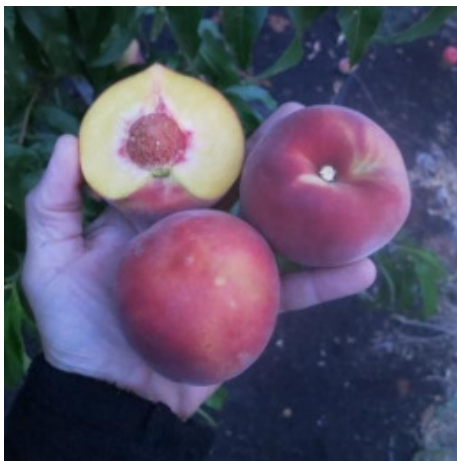
### **FTIA 075**

An interspecific apricot with yellow skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 58mm. A medium texture flesh with balanced flavour and a brix of 13%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 27/11/2013 Overall Score: 5/10



### **FTN 1111**

A white nectarine with 90% solid dark red skin. An ovate shape with an average size of 68mm. A juicy and crunchy flesh with a very sweet flavour and a brix of 14%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 27/11/2013 Overall Score: 7/10



### **FTP 0722**

A yellow peach with a 70% blushed red skin. A rounded shape with an average size of 70mm. A juicy and medium textured flesh with a balanced flavour and a brix of 11%. An average flower density and an average crop load were recorded for this season. First Pick: 27/11/2013 Overall Score: 5.5/10
